Ada Food Pantry Ada Churches take turns staffing the Food Pantry, each covering two months of the year; our months are **September** and February. The hours are Tuesdays from 4:00 - 6:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 10:00 am until Noon. We need at least four people at a time - just in case. Please see Deacon Mike or Deb Driscoll for more information about volunteering at the Food Pantry. *The Food Pantry needs: Tomato & Spaghetti Sauce, Baked Beans & Chili Beans, Instant Mashed Potatoes, Baking Mixes, Cereal, Hamburger Helper.* There are still a few spaces left!

Register for the Parish School of Religion (PSR) We need to have current registration forms for each of the children attending the PSR and families must be registered with the parish to register for the PSR. Registration forms - PSR and parish - are on the top row of the literature rack in the vestibule. Registrations may be returned via the box on the table in the vestibule. **Classes will begin on September 12 with an OPEN HOUSE. Preschool is at 9:00 (during Mass) and Grades K-12 at 10:00. Preschool** is for children 3 years old and potty-trained up to Kindergarten age. The next level is **Kindergarten and First Grade.** *Parents may choose either the 9:00 Preschool class or the 10:00 K-1 class for their children in Kindergarten.* Children in **Grade 2** will be prepared in the first half of the year and will celebrate their First Reconciliation on December 12 and be prepared in the second half of the year and celebrate their First Communion on May 7. Our PSR Grades 3 & 4 are combined, Grades 5 & 6 are combined, and Grades 8 through 12 are combined. **Grade 7** students are prepared and will celebrate their Confirmation on February 11 - here at Our Lady of Lourdes this year -on the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes!

ONU classes resume on September 6. We are hosting a reception for the incoming freshmen in the parish hall on September 5, immediately following the 11:00 Mass. If you would like to provide a college-kid-pleasing refreshment for the reception, sign up on the sheet in the vestibule.

Sacraments & Devotions at Our Lady of Lourdes

Mass: (Sept. - May) Saturday - 5:00 pm ~ Sunday 9:00 am & 11:00 am* ~ * Second Sunday of each month (during ONU school year), 11:15 at English Chapel
 On the Fourth Sunday of each month, when ONU classes are in session, there is a Third Sunday Mass at 8:30 pm in the English Chapel.
Mass: (June - August) Saturday - 5:00 pm and Sunday - 10:00 am ~ **Daily Mass** (All year): Monday through Thursday at 9:00 a.m.

Confessions: Every Saturday - 4:30 - 4:45 pm or by appointment.
 Communal Penance Services in Advent* and Lent
 *includes First Reconciliation for PSR Grade 2 students

Baptisms: Parents wishing to have their child baptized are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance. Baptisms are normally celebrated within one of our Sunday Masses, but may also be scheduled on Sunday afternoons, directly following the last Mass.

Marriage: Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date, or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor.

Confirmation: Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

RCIA: The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is the process by which an adult becomes a member of the Catholic Church. If you, or someone you know, is interested in joining the Church, please contact the pastor for more information. For preparation and celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for children (outside of the Parish School of Religion) contact the Pastor.
