Holy Family Sunday, December 26, Masses are at 9:00 and 11:00 a.m.

Important Notice: There will NOT be a Saturday evening Vigil Mass on December 25th for Sunday, December 26, per Diocesan policy. Masses for fulfilling the Sunday obligation are 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. on Sunday.

Christmas Eve Singers The 5:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve is when we have a choir (and sometimes a musical ensemble) made up of our parish's children and young people. We begin with carols before Mass at 4:30 p.m. You have to arrive early to get a seat! Seating is at a premium and our parish does not allow seats to be reserved for this Mass. There is overflow seating in the parish hall. **Permission Slips** for singing in the Christmas Eve Choir have been handed out to the appropriate age groups in PSR and need to be returned on December 5th; rehearsals will be in the Church, during the PSR hour.

Sacraments & Devotions at Our Lady of Lourdes

Mass: (Sept. - May) Saturday - 5:00 pm ~ Sunday 9:00 am & 11:00 am* ~* Second Sunday of each month (during ONU school year), 11:15 at English Chapel
 On the Fourth Sunday of each month, when ONU classes are in session, there is a Third Sunday Mass at 8:30 pm in the English Chapel.

Mass: (June - August) Saturday - 5:00 pm and Sunday - 10:00 am ~ **Daily Mass** (All year): Monday through Thursday at 9:00 a.m.

Confessions: Every Saturday - 4:30 - 4:45 pm or by appointment.
 Communal Penance Services in Advent* and Lent
 *includes First Reconciliation for PSR Grade 2 students

Baptisms: Parents wishing to have their child baptized are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance. Baptisms are normally celebrated within one of our Sunday Masses, but may also be scheduled on Sunday afternoons, directly following the last Mass.

Marriage: Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date, or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor.

Confirmation: Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

RCIA: The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is the process by which an adult becomes a member of the Catholic Church. If you, or someone you know, is interested in joining the Church, please contact the pastor for more information. For preparation and celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for children (outside of the Parish School of Religion) contact the Pastor.
