All parishioners are invited to pick up a Rice Bowl or simply make regular contributions for CRS throughout Lent. *Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving are traditional Lenten practices and Operation Rice Bowl offers our young people the opportunity to learn about and participate in those practices: **Fast** from a food or treat, **Give** that amount in the Rice Bowl, **Pray** for those in need of our care.* PSR students will hold their annual Rice Bowl Bake Sale on Sunday, March 7 at 10:00 a.m. in the parish hall.
