Help Wanted: Liturgical Ministers (Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Communion and Altar Servers) willing to serve the 11:00 Masses during the school year. *We do have some Ohio Northern students who are willing to serve the 11:00 Mass but need more parishioners available, especially for when students are on break.* If you are willing to switch your preference or if you would like to be trained for liturgical ministry, please drop a note in the collection or send an email to oll@wcoil.com

Protecting God's Children (PGC) is the program our Diocese uses for training adults to protect children from sexual abuse: to learn how to recognize abusers/potential abusers and learn how to recognize and prevent the problematic situations that can lead to abuse.

Immaculate Conception Church is hosting a PGC session on **Saturday, July 31 at 9:00 a.m.**

ALL of our PSR staff are PGC trained! ANYONE who has sustained contact - outside of the parents' view - with our parish's children is required to undergo a fingerprint and background check and attend a 3 hour PGC training session. Only those who are in compliance with these Diocesan guidelines can be considered as volunteers for the Parish School of Religion and Vacation Bible School. The PSR and our summer VBS program can only benefit from more trained volunteers. *Please consider taking the training even if you don't wish to volunteer with VBS or PSR; it is good information for anyone who would like to learn how to protect our children and young people from predators!*

To Register for the PGC session at Immaculate Conception: Go to virtusonline.org and click on **Registration**. Click on **View a list of upcoming sessions**. Select **Columbus, OH (Diocese)** Select **Start Registration**. You will be directed to set up a user account in order to register. Follow instructions from there to register for the session at Immaculate Conception on July 31. All registrations for PGC sessions must be done via the Virtus website.

Our PSR Minister, Desiree Tosatto, will be taking the training to be a PGC Program Facilitator and we will be able to offer the training here at OLL sometime at the end of 2010 or beginning of 2011.

Sacraments & Devotions at Our Lady of Lourdes

Mass: (Sept. - May) Saturday - 5:00 pm ~ Sunday 9:00 am & 11:00 am* ~* Second Sunday of each month (during ONU school year), 11:15 at English Chapel
 On the Fourth Sunday of each month, when ONU classes are in session, there is a Third Sunday Mass at 8:30 pm in the English Chapel.

Mass: (June - August) Saturday - 5:00 pm and Sunday - 10:00 am ~ **Daily Mass** (All year): Monday through Thursday at 9:00 a.m.

Confessions: Every Saturday - 4:30 - 4:45 pm or by appointment.

Communal Penance Services in Advent* and Lent

*includes First Reconciliation for PSR Grade 2 students

Baptisms: Parents wishing to have their child baptized are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance. Baptisms are normally celebrated within one of our Sunday Masses, but may also be scheduled on Sunday afternoons, directly following the last Mass.

Marriage: Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date, or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor.

Confirmation: Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

RCIA: The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is the process by which an adult becomes a member of the Catholic Church. If you, or someone you know, is interested in joining the Church, please contact the pastor for more information. For preparation and celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for children (outside of the Parish School of Religion) contact the Pastor.
