Sacraments & Devotions at Our Lady of Lourdes

Mass: (Sept. - May) Saturday - 5:00 pm ~ Sunday 9:00 am & 11:00 am* ~* Second Sunday of each month (during ONU school year), 11:15 at English Chapel
On the Fourth Sunday of each month, when ONU classes are in session, there is a Third Sunday Mass at 8:30 pm in the English Chapel.
Mass: (June - August) Saturday - 5:00 pm and Sunday - 10:00 am ~ **Daily Mass** (All year): Monday through Thursday at 9:00 a.m.

Confessions: Every Saturday - 4:30 - 4:45 pm or by appointment.
Communal Penance Services in Advent* and Lent
*includes First Reconciliation for PSR Grade 2 students

Baptisms: Parents wishing to have their child baptized are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance. Baptisms are normally celebrated within one of our Sunday Masses, but may also be scheduled on Sunday afternoons, directly following the last Mass.

Marriage: Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date, or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor.

Confirmation: Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

RCIA: The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is the process by which an adult becomes a member of the Catholic Church. If you, or someone you know, is interested in joining the Church, please contact the pastor for more information. For preparation and celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for children (outside of the Parish School of Religion) contact the Pastor.

From the bulletin of St. Anthony Parish, Columbus Grove, sent in by a kind parishioner of OLL:

As this Year for Priests draws to a close... The average parish priest is celebrant, teacher, counselor and minister as well as C.E.O., C.F.O., and C.O.O. of his parish (and in some cases multiple parishes), doing everything from administering sacraments to taking out the trash. Yet, nine out of ten priests report being happy in their ministry and glad to be priests. *So, what do our parish priests need from us?* Our support will help them stay strong in their faith and true to their calling: **Pray for him every day.** Let him know of your prayers; that knowledge will strengthen him in difficult times. **Express appreciation.** Tell him when something he has done or said has made a difference to you. Drop him an encouraging note or email. **Wait for facts.** A visible position such as his can attract negativity and misunderstanding. Until you have all the facts, give your priest the benefit of the doubt. **Roll up your sleeves.** A priest's job is easier if each one of us uses our gifts and talents in our parishes. **Attend Mass.** The best thing we can each do to support our priests is to attend Mass - every weekend, Holy Day, and during the week whenever you can. Acting in Jesus' name and celebrating the Mass is the best part of being a priest.
