RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

If you know of someone who would like to learn more about the Catholic faith, please invite them to come to RCIA Sundays, from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m. in the parish hall. New participants are accepted up to the end of November. RCIA may be appropriate for inactive Catholics who would like to return to the sacramental life of the Church. Those interested may register, request info, or request an appointment with Fr. Dave by email to oll@wcoil.com.

RCIA is set up for adults only. The process for those with children in need of Christian Initiation (sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and/or Confirmation) and Catholic education is as follows: First, contact Deb Driscoll, PSR Administrator (and Parish Secretary) in person or by email to the parish office at oll@wcoil.com or meet with Desiree Tosatto, PSR Minister, at 10:00 a.m. on Sundays at her desk upstairs (above the parish hall) or contact Fr. Dave by phone at 419-634-2626 or by email to the office (oll@wcoil.com) to request an appointment. During your first meeting, you will be asked to register with the parish and register your children with the PSR (Parish School of Religion); you will be given the appropriate textbook for working at home to prepare your child and plan a date for the reception of the sacrament(s). While you are working with your child at home, your child will be expected to attend PSR classes with their peers. You may ask for meetings for guidance at any time during the process; at one month before the date intended for the celebration of the sacrament you will need to make an appointment with Fr. Dave to assess your child's readiness and confirm or reset the date for the reception of the sacrament(s).

Sacraments & Devotions at Our Lady of Lourdes

Mass: (Sept. - May) Saturday - 5:00 pm ~ Sunday 9:00 am & 11:00 am* ~* Second Sunday of each month (during ONU school year), 11:15 at English Chapel
 On the Fourth Sunday of each month, when ONU classes are in session, there is a Third Sunday Mass at 8:30 pm in the English Chapel.
Mass: (June - August) Saturday - 5:00 pm and Sunday - 10:00 am ~ **Daily Mass** (All year): Monday through Thursday at 9:00 a.m.

Confessions: Every Saturday - 4:30 - 4:45 pm or by appointment.

 *includes First Reconciliation for PSR Grade 2 students

Baptisms: Parents wishing to have their child baptized are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance. Baptisms are normally celebrated within one of our Sunday Masses, but may also be scheduled on Sunday afternoons, directly following the last Mass.

Marriage: Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date, or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor.

Confirmation: Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

RCIA: The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is the process by which an adult becomes a member of the Catholic Church. If you, or someone you know, is interested in joining the Church, please contact the pastor for more information. For preparation and celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for children (outside of the Parish School of Religion) contact the Pastor.
