RCIA may be appropriate for inactive Catholics who would like to return to the sacramental life of the Church.* Those interested may register, request info, or request an appointment with Fr. Dave by email to oll@wcoil.com. *RCIA is set up for adults only; if you have children who need Catholic education and sacraments please contact Fr. Dave to make an appointment to discuss the options available for children. You may also talk with the PSR Minister, Desiree Tosatto, Sundays during PSR at her desk upstairs.*

Sacraments & Devotions at Our Lady of Lourdes

Mass: (Sept. - May) Saturday - 5:00 pm ~ Sunday 9:00 am & 11:00 am* ~* Second Sunday of each month (during ONU school year), 11:15 at English Chapel
On the Fourth Sunday of each month, when ONU classes are in session, there is a Third Sunday Mass at 8:30 pm in the English Chapel.
Mass: (June - August) Saturday - 5:00 pm and Sunday - 10:00 am ~ **Daily Mass** (All year): Monday through Thursday at 9:00 a.m.

Confessions: Every Saturday - 4:30 - 4:45 pm or by appointment.
Communal Penance Services in Advent* and Lent
*includes First Reconciliation for PSR Grade 2 students

Baptisms: Parents wishing to have their child baptized are asked to make an appointment with the pastor, at least one month in advance. Baptisms are normally celebrated within one of our Sunday Masses, but may also be scheduled on Sunday afternoons, directly following the last Mass.

Marriage: Couples who wish to marry in the Catholic Church are asked to contact the pastor at least six months *in advance*, in order to meet with him before setting a date, or making any further arrangements. Couples are also required to attend an approved marriage preparation course, in addition to regular meetings with the pastor.

Confirmation: Students in Seventh Grade (& any in Grades 8-12 who are not confirmed) prepare & celebrate the Sacrament each year. College students & other adults who wish to be Confirmed should contact the Pastor.

Anointing of the Sick: Communal celebrations of this sacrament occur twice annually (Advent & Lent). Individual anointings are available upon request, or by appointment. Should you have family or friends in need of the sacrament, please contact the pastor as soon as possible.

RCIA: The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is the process by which an adult becomes a member of the Catholic Church. If you, or someone you know, is interested in joining the Church, please contact the pastor for more information. For preparation and celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation for children (outside of the Parish School of Religion) contact the Pastor.

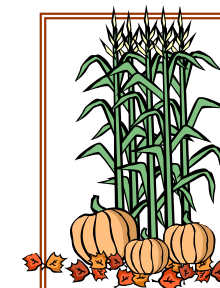

class each week. The "assigned" items are staples that the Food Pantry always needs

Preschool, Kindergarten, Grade One: Macaroni & Cheese

Grade Two: Tomato (or Spaghetti) Sauce 16-18oz. cans

Grades Three and Four: Peanut Butter /Jelly (18 oz)

Grades Five and Six: Instant Mashed Potatoes

Grade 7: Beans (Dry Beans, Baked Beans, Chili Beans)

OLLY, Grades 8-12: Hamburger Helper /Rice-a-roni

YOU ARE INVITED to help the PSR Children gather these items. To add to their "stock piles" you may visit the classrooms upstairs and drop off food or leave it in the parish hall. At the end of the Food Drive, each class will make a field trip to the Food Pantry to deliver and put away the food and to see where it is and what the Pantry looks like.

Also: The Food Pantry always needs Canned Meats, Cake mixes and Frosting, Canned Fruit, Jello and Pudding.

Reminder: We will once again put up our Advent Giving Tree at the end of November. This activity is for donating toiletries (shampoo, toothpaste, Soap, Deodorant, Kleenex, Hand Sanitizer, etc.) for Food Pantry Patrons.
